# **Academic Calendar for the Session 2025-2026**

The Department of Education, Government of Assam has instructed to develop a uniform Academic Calendar for elementary, secondary and higher secondary classes and has directed to implement the same in all Schools of Assam. Accordingly, Assam State School Education Board, Div-II has prepared this Academic Calendar for the session 2025-2026 (1st April, 2025 - 31st March, 2026) for Higher Secondary and Senior Secondary Schools in the State.

As per provision of the Assam State School Education Board Act, 2024 the erstwhile Board of Secondary Education, Assam (SEBA) and Assam Higher Secondary Education Council (AHSEC) have been merged with effect from 13th September, 2024 and the new board "Assam State School Education Board" has come into existence. Accordingly, Assam Higher Secondary Education Council (AHSEC) is now known as ASSAM STATE SCHOOL EDUCATION BOARD, DIVISION-II. In exercise of powers conferred under section 30 read with section 30.2.(B) of the Assam State School Education Act, 2024, the ASSEB, Division-II is for imparting secondary education for Class-XI (HS 1st Year) and Class-XII (HS 2nd Year).

The monthly Academic Wall Calendar is for all Higher Secondary Schools and Senior Secondary Schools for the Session 2025-26, imparting Senior Secondary Course under ASSEB, Div-II..

It is expected that the Institutions will follow this calendar towards improving the academic atmosphere in our State.

#### **General Instructions:**

- 1. The Heads of the institution(s) shall convene meeting with the teaching staff conveniently to discuss and finalize the academic activities in the light of this Calendar. The meeting shall finalize the class routine as per model routine given with this Calendar.
- 2. The Heads of the institution(s) shall constitute different Committees from amongst the teachers like
  - I Academic Committee,
  - II. Examination Committee,
  - III. Festival Celebration Committee,
  - IV. Students' Activities Committee,
  - V. Parent Teacher Relation Committee,
  - VI. Unit Test Committee,
  - VII. Co-curricular Activity Committee etc.

These Committees will be responsible for smooth functioning of different programs of the Institutions.

- 3. Lessonwise distributions of the key subjects of Arts, Science & Commerce stream have been displayed in every month of the Academic Calendar. These are just some examples of lesson distributions in this calendar. All teachers will prepare monthly lesson distribution of respective subject to cover the syllabus within the period.
- 4. Head of the Institutions shall ask the teachers to prepare subjectwise work schedule of those subjects which are not included in the action plan of this calendar and discuss the syllabi contents amongst the teachers of respective subject. The Academic Committee will take initiative in this plan.
- 5. The regular classes shall begin from 9.15 A.M. onwards, everyday
- 6. Full classes will be taken on all working days including Saturdays. Saturday shall not be treated as half working day.
- 7. The Head of the Institutions should ensure and maintain the norms laid down in the Rules & Regulations notified by ASSEB, Div-II time to time in recognition, academic permission, conduct of examinations etc.
- 8. The Institutions will prepare their own class routine, by following the model routine of ASSEB, Div-II published in this calendar, 2025-26
- 9. The class routine as included in this Calendar shall be strictly followed in such a manner that the duration of period and total number of classes per subject are not reduced.

- 10. The first period for Higher Secondary Classes is for 45 minutes duration. The last period is of 35 minutes. The other classes must be 40 minutes in all the institutions. It is to be maintained strictly.
- 11. Dates of Holidays may be changed subject to Govt. Notification.
- 12. The Unit Tests shall be conducted as per schedule mentioned in the Academic Calendar. The records of such tests should be analyzed immediately after completion of each test and should be taken necessary remedial measures for academic improvement of the students. The Unit Test Committee will take initiative for proper execution.
- 13. The ASSEB, Div-II will issue necessary instructions in due course of time for holding of Class-XI/Class-XII, submission of registration forms, examination forms etc.
- 14. At the beginning of the academic session, it is imperative to discuss the syllabus and textbook for deriving the skills/competencies envisaged in the curriculum and syllabus. The Academic Committee will take initiative with the supervision of the Head of the Institution.
- 15. It is expected that the Head of the Institutions will take necessary steps for proper implementation of this Academic Calendar for achieving desired level of academic improvement of the students in general, and of the institutions in particular.
- 16. The Academic Calendar must be followed by the concerned Institutions for maintaining healthy atmosphere.
- 17. Any suggestion for improvement of academic activities at Senior Secondary is highly solicited for designing future course of action.

ASSEB, Div-II (Erstwhile AHSEC) has been selecting a theme, to reflect at the Academic Calendar of every year for the sake of some knowledge and information to the students as well as to the teachers. Like previous years (such as, 150 years of Birth of Mahatma Gandhi, Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav, G-20,



ISRO etc.), ASSEB, Div-II has selected the theme "Year of the Book" (কিতাপৰ বৰ্ষ) to be reflected at the Academic Calendar, 2025-26.

All heads of the institutions and all teachers are honorably requested to create an environment of reading of books in their Institutions, more library time, book reading related competitions, prize to the highest book-reader student of the month/year, students exposure to visit book fair, district library etc.

## Activities for the Higher Secondary Schools/Sr.Secondary Schools for the Mental Health of Students

Sudden break out of COVID-19 has brought a wave of change to every aspect of human life. Mental health was not an exception. With the changing world, the mental health of human beings, specially of students has drastically degraded. Keeping themselves within locked area, no outing, no playing in play ground, no face to face interaction with friends, no physical activity, learning only through screen, scarcity of mobile, problems with network, degradation of financial status of parents etc, affect the mental health of our students. It has possessed a major challenge to keep the mental health of students intact. Social isolations, degrading health condition, lock down were the major threat to mental health under the prevaiting circumstances. It is of utmost important to keep the mental health intact of the students.

As long as the physical classes have been starting at Schools/educational institutions, it is our duty to keep up the mental health of the students. The teachers should take the responsibility for growing sound mental health of the students along with their routined teaching. The head of the institutions should take initiative for better mental health of all students.

For this purpose, the educational institutions can take some activites like -

- 1. The educational institutions can organise **counselling sessions by inviting a psychologis**t. Students should be given opportunities to have a face to face session with the psychologist.
- 2. The institutions can **arrange popular talk** by inviting a psychologist.
- Can invite motivational speaker to **address the common problem of the students** and to provide the techniques to cope up with it.
- 4. G. Stanley Hall (American psychologist) referred to adolescence as the period of "storm and stress". During this stage an adolescent goes through various changes and they are exposed to vivid emotions. At this stage, the tension related to career also arises. They are unable to recognise their aptitude and are mostly confused with which career path they should opt for, depending on their calibre. In this regard, the Educational institutions may organise some **Talks or discussions regarding the career opportunities and guide** them by inviting some professional career mentors.
- It is very important to keep the minds occupied. To ensure that the schedules are packed, and minds are alert. Free time should be used to keep the individuals busy through various activities like art, craft, music, cooking, play etc. It will not only enable them to use their leisure properly but also develop the creative ability of individuals.

  Workshops can be organised by inviting some local artist of various sphere e.g- art and craft, music, dance, recitation, creative writing etc for the students.
- Skill enhancement programmes also can be arranged for the students which may help them in the future.
  In teaching-learning process, the teachers should handle the students very delicately, so that students will not be more stressed. Teachers/Principals as well as the guardens should inspire students at all time for joyful teaching learning.

These are some suggestions from ASSEB, Div-II. The Principals/Teachers may take some innovative ideas for improving the mental health of the students according to their positions.

### **INFORMATIONS REGARDING CHANGE IN SYLLABUS & CURRICULUM**

### 1. Change in Curriculum in 2025-26

There are some special and significant informations to all concerned Schools / Senior Secondary / Degree Colleges / Universities who impart the Higher Secondary Courses under ASSAM STATE SCHOOL EDUCATION BOARD, DIVISION-II.

- ❖ The changes have been made in the curriculum of class XI and class XII. Accordingly, the revised curriculum will be effective from the academic session 2025-26 for Class -XI (H.S. 1st Year) and from 2026-27 for Class XII (H.S. 2nd Year).
- For the students of Science and Commerce stream English and MIL/Alt. English is compulsory to pass. They have to select another four (4) subjects from Group-B or C. The student must have to appear in six (6) subjects and the result will be declared as pass, only if the students will secure 33% of marks in aggregate, in spite of the fact that even if he/she fails in one subject out of the four elective subjects. However, passing in English and MIL/Alt. English is compulsory.
- ❖ For the students of Arts stream, English and MIL is compulsory to pass. They have to choose three (3) subjects from Group-B and one (1) subject from Group-C. The student must have to appear in six (6) subjects and the result will be declared as pass, only if the students will secure 33% of marks in aggregate, in spite of the fact that even if he/she fails in one subject out of the four elective subjects. However, passing in English and MIL/Alt.English is compulsory.
- For all the skill based elective subject containing in Group-C, the apportionment of marks for practical and theoretical part will be in the ratio of 50:50

### 2. Introduction of three new subjects for Class- XI

- ❖ ASSEB, Div-II has introduced three new subjects viz (i) Sign Language, (ii) Artificial Intelligence & (iii) Financial Literacy for class XI to be implemented from the academic session 2025-26 in schools/colleges having HS course and only where wiling and competent teachers are available.
- (I) Sign Language: To provide communication access to deaf and hard of hearing people in various settings in real life and to spread awareness about Indian Sign language (ISL) to support individuals with disabilities and as the implementation of NEP 2020 envisages inclusive education and use of ISL, the subject Sign Language will be introduced in colleges and schools. The teacher or resource person having B.Ed. in special education should be available in the Institution. Any such competent teacher available in any primary or upper primary or high school or resource person of SSA, he or she may take classes of this subject in nearby HSS/SSS/College.
- (II) Artificial Intelligence: To improve the students to build digital literacy, critical thinking, creativity and problem-solving skills, the subject Artificial Intelligence will be introduced in colleges and schools. Any competent teacher having knowledge in Al/Computer Education available in any Higher Secondary/Senior Secondary school/Colleges, may take classes of this subject.
- (III) Financial Literacy: To help students to make informed financial decisions by an understanding of key financial facts and concepts, the Subject Financial Literacy will be introduced in colleges and schools. Any competent teacher available in any Higher Secondary /Senior Secondary School/Colleges may take classes of this subject.
- The training of teachers of these three subjects will be provided by ASSEB, Div-II, only after enrolment of students in Class-XI in 2025-26 Academic Session.
- ASSEB, Div-II has prepared the textbooks of (i) Sign Language, (ii) Artificial Intelligence & (iii) Financial Literacy for Class- XI which will be available for students and teachers in due time.

#### 7. Introduction of Tai Language

As per direction of Hon'ble CM, Dr. Himanta Biswa Sarma, AHSEC has introduced a new elective subject "Tai Language" in H.S. Course. It has been implemented from 2023-24 Academic Session. Accordingly, with the help of Purbanchal Tai Sahitya Sabha and Centre for Language Studies, Dibrugarh University, textbooks has been developed namely "Lit Kham", for Class-XI in 2023-24 and "Lit Kham", for Class-XII in 2024-25.

The textbook was inaugurated by Dr. Himanta Biswa Sarma, Hon'ble Chief Minister, Assam on 02.08.2023 at CM's office in a programme organized by Purbanchal Tai Sahitya Sabha.

#### 8. Revision of the subject Sanskrit in 2025-26

ASSEB, Div-II (Erstwhile AHSEC) has taken the initiative to revise the syllabus of the subject Sanskrit for Class- XI to be implemented from the academic session 2025-26. Accordingly, a new textbook for Class- XI has been developed as per NCF-2023 which will be available for students of Class- XI in open market. The revised textbook for Class- XII will be implemented from 2026-27 academic session.

#### 9. Introduction of Bodo Medium in ASSEB, Div-II (Erstwhile AHSEC) Course

In compliance of direction of the Government of Assam, the Board has introduced the Bodo medium of instruction, initially in Arts Stream comprising the following subjects for class-XI in 2023-24 and consequently for class-XII in 2024-25 Academic Session.

#### 10. Introduction of project works

In the light of National Education Policy, 2020, ASSEB, Div-II (Erstwhile AHSEC) has introduced project work in some of the subjects.

The marks considered for the project work is 20 marks out of 100. So in these subjects, the marks in the theory part is 80 marks.

Accordingly, AHSEC has developed a SOP for project works.

#### The Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for implementation of Project Works Background

AHSEC has introduced project works on few subjects since 2018-19 academic session keeping in view that project based learning helps students get involved in their learning. Through project based learning, students get to know to identify problems and their solutions and as such gain necessary knowledge to find plausible solutions, which give successful outcomes.

Project based learning for the students of H.S. 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> year is only possible with the proper guidance of the teachers. A teacher needs to guide his/her students in designing projects based on their abilities, keeping in view that the project work builds their confidence. So, involvement of both the teachers and their student's are most important for accomplishing a project- individually or in a group whichever is convenient for a particular teacher.

#### Ready reckoner to implement the Project Works

- 1. Students may be given project work individually or in a group depending on the total number of students in a particular subject.
- 2. The concerned teacher must provide guidance to the students in selection of project and its preparation

- 16. The earlier notification of AHSEC, vide No AHSEC/ACA/144/99/B-111/374 dated 08/12/2022 shall be applicable for the purpose of distribution of marks on project works.
